Hello Bethel,

It is not about us looking good-that kind of piety does not give God any glory. It is also for the benefit of others-and that gives God glory. If it is for our own benefit-if the outcome only benefits me or makes me look good-that kind of piety does not give God any glory. Let's shine our lights in the city of North Platte so that God gets the gloryand the benefits are for those around us!
