#### Hello Bethel!

Ephesians 5:15 "Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk—not as unwise people but as wise— 16 making the most of the time, because the days are evil" (CSB).

- "But as wise" Do we live in everyday wisdom that is seen by those around us so that God is revealed. I have learned that wisdom is making the right choice at the moment of truth. Do I ask for God's insight into every part of my life so that I am not living a compartmentalized faith?

"Making the most of the time" Do I take the time to live differently
than the world. It is said that we should live like we have died, not
like we are dead. The thought is that we are not dead as the world
in rebellion to Christ, but that we have died to sin and now live a
new life.

There are great opportunities ahead for the Bethel Faith Family. Let's pay attention and live the everyday gospel for the world to see!
