- 1. Pronounce these tongue twisters & misspoken words. Then, discuss why accurate pronunciation is important and how to improve.
  - \* *He threw three free throws...Selfish shellfish* (5 times each) \* *February, Sherbet, Nuclear, Often*
- 2. Someone read James 3:2-5a (Our tongues direct where we go).
  - \* Which analogy for the tongue did you find particularly interesting, challenging or convicting i.e. bits in horses mouths, rudders on ships?
  - \* Read & review Proverbs 12:14 & 18; 18:21; 25:11.
  - \* How might the text & tone of our voices change the course of Bethel church over the next few years...for better or worse?
- 3. Someone read James 3:5b-8 (Our tongues can destroy what we have).
  - \* Which of the analogies for the destructive power of the tongue did you find most disturbing i.e. wildfires in a forest, wild animals on a prey?
  - \* Read & review Proverbs 16:26-27; 26:22; Psalm 141:3
  - \* Find & play "The Rumor Mill" song on YouTube (lyrics on reverse side of this page).
  - \* What are some ways to help each other resign from the rumor mill?
- 4. Someone read James 3:9-12 (Our tongues display who we are).
  - \* Which of the analogies did you find particularly enlightening or convicting i.e. pump on a well, fruit of a tree?
  - \* Read & review Matthew 12:34-35; Galatians 5:22-23.
  - \* If our tongues reveal what is in our hearts, what steps can we take to clean them up?
  - \* Read & pray together through Psalm 139:23-24; 51:10; Ephesians 4:29-32; Philippians 4:8; Colossians 3:16.
