- 1. Do you know people who have tested positive for Covid-19, died or suffered loss from it (i.e. jobs, income, fear, depression etc).
 - * Someone read **Psalm 103**, then pray God's protection & provision for these people.
- 2. Have you personally wondered if Covid-19 is a hoax, conspiracy or political ploy?
 - * Which ones and why? What sources have you consulted?
 - * Someone read **Psalm 2:1-5, 10-11** and discuss those theories in light of the Lord's supreme reign.
- 3. Do you believe Covid-19 is more likely an attack of Satan or the judgement of God?
 - * What difference would this make in our response to it i.e. **Ephesians 6:10-18 & 2** Chronicles 7:13-14?

* Overall, how well have you been enduring or persevering through this trial i.e. connection with God, attitudes, relationships with others, ministry etc?
* Someone read James 1:2-4, 12.

- 4. Have you considered that Covid-19 might be a sign preceding the return of the Lord, the rapture of the church and tribulation on earth?
 - * Someone read Luke 21:25-28, 34-36.
 - * What evidence of other signs listed in this passage do you see happening during this time?
- 5. How do you think the church could or should be different as a result of Covid-19?
 - * Someone read Hebrews 10:24-25.
 - * How can we do a better job of encouraging & warning one another?
 - * What do you think about Bethel's emerging mission statement which includes Believing the gospel, Belonging to the body and Becoming more like Jesus?
- 6. What is your honest feeling about the Lord's soon return i.e. excitement, fear, doubt?
