Oddly, the revelation of the Savior of the world was heard by foreigners. These men were those who studied the stars and compared them to the writings of those that had gone before. This revelation wasn't heard by priests, rabbis, or even prophets from the Jewish faith. It was heard and seen by outsiders. It must not have been that spectacular, for then throngs of people would have been writing about it. There was something about this particular star that drew these foreigners to "him." They knew it as "his" star. They traveled in search of a "king," not knowing where it would take them, but knowing that there was something very special about their destination.
