- 1. Let's pretend: What would you do with a huge windfall i.e. lottery win, inheritance, sleeper stocks etc?
 - * How much money would that be...thousands? millions? billions?
- 2. Someone read James 5:1-3 & someone else read Luke 12:16-20.
 - * Is there any connection at all between money and happiness or quality of life?
 - * How would you balance these passages with the wisdom of having savings, making investments and buying insurance?
 - * What are some of the dangers which James associates with great wealth?
- 3. Someone read James 3-6.
 - * Think of someone who is substantially wealthier than you are and someone who has substantially less than you do.
 - * Which of the 4 temptations suggested by James refers is most prevalent among those who are wealthier?
 - 1) To *Hoard* rather than *Help* Read Matthew 6:19-21.
 - > Is there anything you own which is so protected that it is totally off-limits to others?
 - 2) To *Cheat* rather than *Compensate* Read 1 Timothy 5:18.
 - > How does this relate to paying babysitters, tipping servers, supporting Christian workers, churches and ministries etc?
 - 3) To Squander rather than Share Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19.
 - > What guidelines does Paul give in these verses for handling wealth?
 - 3) To *Oppress* rather than *Provide* Read **2** Corinthians 8:9.
